To celebrate the 60th wedding anniversary of Isidore and Anne Goresky, "Uncle Norman" suggested we get a family tree together for distribution. For years he kept track of the family in Canada and recorded it all in October 1970. I am most grateful for his interest and hard work as it would have been a very difficult task to get it all together. I have tried to bring his information up to date with the answers I received from my inquiries and in some cases I relied on family members to fill me in, but this did not work for all. I would have like to have a short history of everyone because some of the younger generations haven't met and I thought it would be interesting to know one another. I would appreciate hearing from those who were not written about and would like to be kept up to date with family additions etc. Please let me know of any mistakes that were made.

No one kept a record of the remaining relatives in Ukraine and it wasn't until Dad began writing to the families there that we received the necessary information as to names and places about the Goruks and the remaining Eustafiewichs. Thanks to Dad's efforts we now have a record of them and some of the generations before them. He translated the letters from the families that dealt with their history and after leafing through them during the past few months, I only wish I would have started this 20 years ago, we may have had more questions answered. He also drew the map with the places mentioned in the biographies together with dates on the history of Ukraine.

I don't know of any record kept of the Maksymchuks and Paleys on Mother's side. What back history I copied was taken from Granmother Mary Paley's autobiography that Dad translated. "Uncle Peter" helped me with the present information which was a great help - thanks! I would appreciate hearing from anyone that can help us out to complete the information we do not have.

To help you follow this family tree, all family names from my grandparent's generation and back are capitalized. Their children's names are underlined.

I hope everyone will enjoy reading this family tree - - - remember keep in touch!

GORESKY FAMILY

The information that is available about the Goresky family in Ukraine comes mostly from George Goruk, Basil Goresky's half brother and Ksenia who was married to Katherine Goruk's son. Ksenia is still living in Cherniwtsi. The first person we have mention of is ANNE a Polish girl, daughter of a dwirnyk (forrester or fieldman) a very high servant of the Lord of the land, probably a chief manager and overseer of the Lord's land and wealth. She came from the village of Zamok near Chernylytsia, Galicia, along the Dniester River. It is recorded that GORUK and ANNE eloped on horse-back escaping across the Prut River, the Cheremosh, Brusnystia, to the village of Panka near Storozynets in the valley of Seret River. Here Goruk was a blacksmith. They had eight children, 3 boys and 5 girls. After Goruk's death Anne married a MATTHEW CHIRAR who originally came from Bessarabia. Chirar was an overseer and blacksmith for the local Lord Yanush. The name Chirar is a mixture of Romanian (probably Moldavian) and Slavic meaning iron-worker. He changed the children's name to Chirar and this name appears on all legal documents. Ivan one of the sons went back to using the name of Goruk and his descendants are known as both. It is with Ivan's family that our family tree begins.

George mentions Goruk's from Zadova but as he lost contact with the rest of the Panka Goruks we don't know if they were of this family or not. The only two children he mentions of the eight is Ivan (his father) and Tanasko (Thomas). Tanasko was a terrible fighter and died as a result of a fight. George did not mention any family. IVAN lived in Kostnyci and later in Zadova. Then he moved to Horishni (Upper) Staniwci where George and his family lived and now his widow and one daughter reside. Ivan was a wheelright by trade, he could work in both iron and wood, as was Basil. In one of George's letters he mentions that Basil looked much like Ivan his father. Basil changed his family name because as a journeyman blacksmith he had to travel to obtain work and the change in name indicated that he was at least distantly related to gentry which might make it easier to obtain some position. Working in many parts of Eastern Europe would account for the fact that Basil could read and write in four languages and speak at least in six. Basil always signed his name as GORECKI and the children born in Manitoba and registered by him were registered as Gorecki. The spelling of the family name as Goresky was done in Canada wherever the registration of the name was necessary and it was never changed. On Isidore's (Basil's oldest son) birth certificate Basil is recorded as Aftanasie Goruk, but must have adopted the name of Basil. It is also interesting to note that on this birth certificate the god-parents were Stefan Blashko, (Mike a son married Isidore's cousin Victoria Eustafiewich in Andrew, Alberta), and Raifta Oleksiyevich half sister to Katherine Eustafiewich nee Oleksiyevich. The priest's name was Nestor "Goretcki".

IVAN born in Panka in 1846 and died in Horishni Staniwci in 1922, was a blacksmith.

George offered information about all the girls but Fruzina, other than that she lived in the village of Broskiwci. Both George and Basil refer to Katherine as their sister so the information is listed in the order George stated. Basil is a son with the first wife, either Fruzina or Katherine are daughters. The other three belong to the second wife. All children were born in Kostyntsi.

BASIL m Victoria Eustafiewich in 1901 in Brusnytsia. Victoria was born in 1884 and died in 1953. Basil came to Canada in 1905 and Victoria came in 1906 with Isidore and Victor. They settled in Stony Mountain, Manitoba, where Basil was employed at a limestone quarry. Both Basil and Victoria are buried in Victoria All Saints Anglican Cemetery 4 miles north of Junction of Stonewall Road and Highway 7 and ¼ mile west. After Basil's death Victoria married WASYL GORA who was born in Voloka, Ukraine, March 18, 1883 and died April 20, 1963. Basil and Victoria's children are:

Isidore m Anne Paley June 19, 1921 at Rosa, Manitoba. He began teaching in the fall of 1918, at Arborg, Manitoba, then moved to a school at Rosa, Manitoba, about twelve miles east of Arnaud. In 1922 he graduated with a Second Class Certificate. During the next four years he continued teaching in Baskerville School in Rosa, Happy Thought School in East Selkirk and Willow Plains School in Sarto. While in East Selkirk he attended evening and Saturday morning classes so that he not only completed his Bachelor's degree in 1926, but also obtained a First Class Certificate. He obtained his B. A. degree with majors in English and History. In 1926 he moved to Alberta to become Principal at Smoky Lake. In 1927 he registered with the University of Alberta to resume his extra-mural studies. He specialized in History and obtained his M. A. degree in 1929. In 1930 he was elected to the provincial legislature but was defeated in 1935 and moved to Edmonton. During the next ten years he was rector of the Ukrainian M. Hrushewsky Institute for 1 year, a teacher in Edmonton Public Schools for four years, a School Superintendent in Consort School Division in Alberta, an officer of the R. C. A. F. He completed

his thesis after his discharge for a Master of Education in 1945. After remaining in Consort for two more years he was transferred to Thorhild School Division where he remained as Superintendent until 1966, when he was appointed to the position of Associate Director of Curriculum. He became a member of the Elementary Reading Committee and also Chairman of the High School Committee on Ukrainian. He was able to persuade his school board to obtain language laboratories, and his schools were almost certainly the first in Canada to experiment with these aids to language teaching. Since his retirement he has assisted in the publishing of three books about Ukrainian Pioneers of Alberta. He also translated Stechishin's History of Ukrainian Settlement in Canada. In 1978 he was honored by the students of Smoky Lake School with a theme "Ring the Bell" - A tribute to Isidore Goresky. In 1979 in January - February issue of Alberta Heritage Magazine on the back page was his picture and story by the Edmonton Historical Society for outstanding services in preserving our heritage. When Isidore was in Bukovyna in 1962 both Katherine and Nykolay were still living in Storozhynets. Nykolay died soon after and Katherine died in 1964.

OLEKSIYEVICH FAMILY

Katherine's father Todyr Oleksiyevich married two or three times. He was fluent in both the Ukrainian and Romanian languages. He was brought to Barbiwtsi by a rich village landowner from the village of Presekuriany almost directly south of Cherniwtsi. His two children from his first wife were Katherine and a son Ivan. Ivan came to Stony Mountain and lived close by his sister Katherine's daughter Victoria and Basil. Apparently for some reason Ivan and Katherine were not on speaking terms, but the women of the households were. Ivan's wife's death was reported as being 1920 and a son George left home shortly after and was never heard from again. Mike the youngest of the two boys was nick-named "Slab", He was a carpenter by trade, married but no offspring, died sometime ago. He is buried at Green Acres on No. 1 Highway east of Winnipeg. There were four girls Katarina, Eudokia, Frozina (Rose), Pauline. Todyr's other children were Raifta and Menodor.

Todyr (Theodore) Oleksiyevich m a woman by the name of Smulsky, their children were Ivan and Katherine (2) no name of second wife - had two daughters that stayed in Ukraine. (3) no name of wife's name - Menodor and Raifta

Ivan m - no record of whom - 4 daughters and 2 sons.

Pauline m Hawryk(Howard) live in Winnipeg

Katherine m Andronyk a farmer at or near Roblin, had a family and is buried at Stony Mountain Cemetery.

Eudkia m Kozna, live in Winnipeg.

Rose m Alex Proskurniak, live in Winnipeg, no record of family.

Menodor m a woman by the name of Orletsky - had 2 children. His wife left him. No record where Menodor is buried.

Raifta m Nykolai Danko. Raifta b 1882 d 1939. Danko b 1879 d 1952. Both are buried in Stony Mountain Cemetery.

Daughter Mary m Jan Badowski - no children.

Allan and Betty Goresky used to visit a Mike and Alma Oleksiyevich in Lockport. They knew they were distant relatives. Mike died of brain cancer quite a few years ago. They didn't have any children. There is also a family named Knysh in Lockport that are somehow related to Allan's mother (Victoria), but we do not have any further information about them.

EUSTAFIEWICH FAMILY

Eustafiewich family were landowners in Carpathian Mountains. IVAN came to Barbiwtsi under the auspices of a local squire or landowner whose name was Kalmutsky. He granted Ivan land which stretched throughout the whole village. At the same time Kalmutsky brought to the same village a teacher and he was also a church cantor. It is also known that Ivan was a priest. He had two sons:

Ivan and George

Ivan continued on in school and became a priest. He also had two sons:

Kost and Onism

We did not receive any information to complete this early family but we do know one of the sons remained in Suchoverchiw. Also we have the names of Emil, Dionisiy, Olga and Katherine. One of the daughters married Reverend W. Melnychuk, who at the time of the gathering of the family history in 1979 was serving the parish at Westlock, Alberta. He died late in 1979. They had two daughters and two sons. Melnychuks escaped Ukraine with their family. One of the sons was lost during the escape and the other one returned to Ukraine. His name is Sviatoslaw and he lives in Cherniwtsi. He teaches music and has a beautiful baritone. He is married to Myroslava and they have a son Thor who is attending University in Cherniwtsi. Sviatoslaw has been in Canada twice. One of the daughters married Reverend E. Trufyn, who was Secretary of the Consistory of the Ukrainian Greek Orthodox Church, now residing in Roblin. He served the parish in Flin Flon and I had met them there but was not aware of the closeness of the relationship to our family. The other daughter married Orest Zubritsky of Vegreville, Alberta.

George remained on the land and it is with his family that our family tree begins, especially with the detailed accounts of Ivan and Katherine and their families.

EUSTAFIEWICH FAMILY CONTINUED:

Ivan had fought in some Austro-Hungarian wars and some officials came to present him with a medal after her died. They would not let Katherine keep it and took it back with them. Ivan died in 1898 leaving Katherine with a young family. He left her with three parcels of land, two parcels were left to the three older children and one parcel was left to the three youngest children. There was enough land to feed the family but there was too little to divide among the children to feed their families when they grew up. Katherine's father Todyr Oleksiyevich came to live with them and as he was wealthy their future looked secure. After a few years he decided to return to his second wife so the future did not hold much in store for Katherine and her family, In 1904 the two oldest daughters came to visit their mother and brought much literature about Canada and Brazil and Argentine. The steamship tickets were free to South America but one had to pay for their fares to Canada. Katherine discovered that she could obtain free passage to Canada in return for persuading others to buy their tickets from the same agent and so she proceeded to bring clients to the agent. She also agreed to sell the two parcels of land and pay the family's fare to Canada but making certain that she would not be left alone and that she would also go to Canada. As the three youngest children were not of age she could not sell the one parcel of land. Agrapina and her husband decided not to leave for Canada and remained on the land. The original house was moved down from the top of the hill closer to the Brusnytsia River. When we were there in 1977 the authorities had built a road through the small orchard leaving the family with the house and garden and the hill on which hay grew for feed for animals. Since Agrapina's death this was also taken away and a road built to the brick factory, leaving Aurelia, the granddaughter and her family only the house and a small garden area. In 1904 Kateryna was able to send her son-in-law Isidore Sichkowski (Elizabeth's husband) to Canada. He settled in Stony Mountain, Manitoba. The next year her other son-in-law Basil Goresky (Victoria's husband) left and her oldest daughter Elizabeth with her small son Victor . In 1906 Victoria left with her two sons Isidore and Victor. Katherine (Kateryna) then sent Elias in 1908 and in 1913 she arrived in Stony Mountain with her son Melety with Isidore the youngest following in August of 1913. About 1910 Sichkowski's moved to Prince Rupert, B. C., where they ran a store with a pool room and rooms for rent. They returned to Andrew, Alberta and in 1917 sold their farm to Isidore Eustafiewich. In 1918 Sichkowski completed the building of a small store and post office at Zawale. He died there November 11, 1918. Elizabeth spent some time helping Isidore and his mother around the farm and then later married Wasyl Wynnychuk and moved to Drumheller, Alberta. He was a coal miner. After his death she lived with her daughter Mary Nasichuk in Powell River, B.C., and is buried there.

Maryna was born there May 12, 1898 before her parents left for Canada. She died August 23, 1975. After Melety left school he apprenticed as a blacksmith for 2 years but returned home to help his mother and in his spare time worked with his brother-in-law Petro Boychuk who was a plasterer and a bricklayer. He had to use a false passport in Isidore's name as Melety was of military age and would not have received permission to leave. He was in constant danger through Austria but arrived in St. John, New Brunswick March 3, 1913, with his mother. He spent the next four years working at the stone quarry in Stony Mountain and later with Winnipeg Electric Railway which was running a street car service from Winnipeg to Stonewall. During this period he and Isidore perfected themselves in the English language organizing for this purpose a school in which they and other young immigrants could be taught English. In November 1916, Melety and Isidore bought a farm in the district of Zawale, Alberta. In 1917 he married Maryna Tomashewsky and they lived there until they retired to Andrew, renting the farm to his grandson. When Melety landed on Canadian soil he looked east and vowed he would never return to Ukraine. His love for his new home and family was evident in his interest in community and provincial affairs. He was also an ardent reader and organized a reading society for and by retired folks. He took his turn reading Ukrainian Classics to interested audiences. This circle has been able to obtain quite a large collection of Ukrainian books through his effort. In the fall of 1939 Melety and Nick Hackman began organizing a co-operative. In 1940 the Andrew Co-operative began with 48 members. Nick bought membership #1 and Melety bought #2. Melety served Andrew Council from the years 1945 to 1950, acting as temporary Mayor in 1947. He had a beautiful voice and I remember so well him singing to us probably while we were waiting for Maryna to cook us one of her appetizing meals. Their children are:
